NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR BIDS  
TRANSPORTATION ROUTES

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Scotch Plains-Fanwood Board of Education (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-4.5 at the Board offices located at 512 Cedar Street, Scotch Plains, New Jersey 07076, from interested vendors for Transportation Routes 2022-2023 in accordance with the Bid Requests prepared by the Board.

A copy of the Bid Requests may be inspected and picked up at the Board offices between the hours of 8:30AM and 4:00PM, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. Bid Requests may also be e-mailed to interested providers upon request.

All vendors submitting bids must use and complete all forms in the manner designated and include all information required in the Bid Requests. The Board assumes no responsibility for bids mailed or misdirected in delivery. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening thereof.

All vendors are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c. 127, "Law Against Discrimination" and the Affirmative Action statutes and regulations, N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1.1 et seq.

Bids must be submitted to the Scotch Plains-Fanwood Board of Education no later than 11:00 AM on Friday, April 29, 2022.

No proposal may be deemed accepted until the adoption of a formal resolution by the Board. The Board anticipates awarding these bids at their meeting on May 10, 2022.
