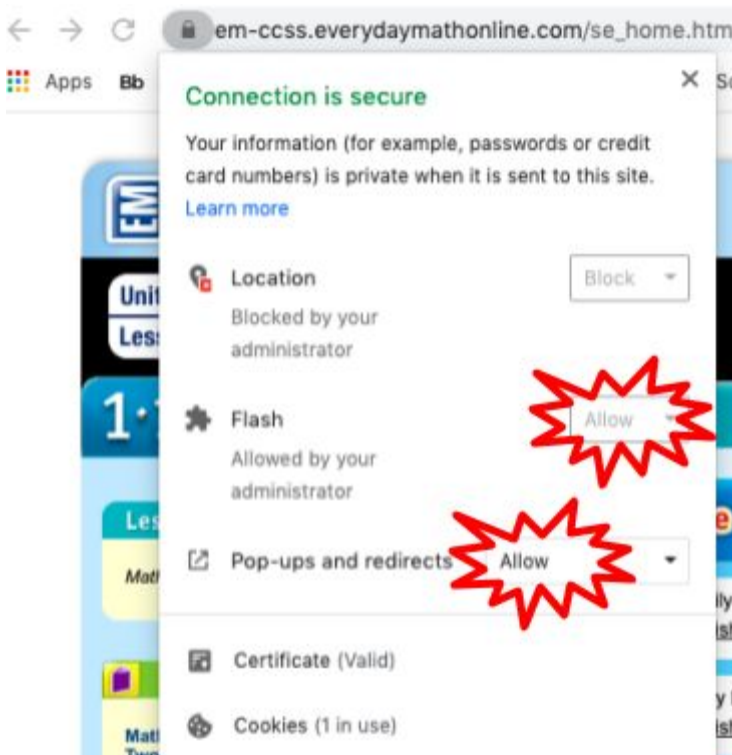
Pop-Ups, Flash, and Cookies

To maximize the functionality of everydaymathonline.com you should use **Google Chrome** as your browser.

After successfully logging in, you should see a lock to the left of the website address bar.



When you click on the lock you should see options for Flash, Pop-ups and redirects, and cookies. To make everydaymathonline.com as functional as possible you will want to "Allow" Flash and "Allow" Pop-ups and redirects.



If prompted, you should also allow any cookies required to run the game.
