



Program Assessment - SPF Boost Program

- Nearly 50% of students enrolled in program met or exceeded expectations on the NJSLA test.
- 83.33% of students performed at or above the "approached expectations" level.
- 83.02% of students met or exceeded their Spring projected outcome as determined by MAP, suggesting that MAP is a strong predictor of NJSLA performance in the district.


