Supply List for Third Grade

- 2 packs of Ticonderoga sharpened pencils
- 2 jumbo Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 blue and 1 red pen
- 8 Expo fine tip black dry erase markers
- 2 black sharpie markers
- 2 highlighters
- 1 storage container that closes (large enough to hold most supplies)
- Pink erasers
- Hand held sharpener

Scissors

- 6 packs of 3x3 post-it notes 3
- 2-pocket folders labeled with your child's name
- 3 marble notebooks (wide ruled)
- 1 1-subject spiral notebook with 3 holes (wide ruled)
- Crayola crayons (no more than 24)
- Package of thin magic marker
- Hand Sanitizer-small bottle
- 1 box of Gallon sized Ziplock Bags Extra

Extra Face mask labeled with child's initials

- **Clorox wipes**
- Earbuds/headphones in plastic baggy labeled with your child's name
- A towel or seat cushion for outdoors
