World language Honor Societies Information for Students in Grades 9-10

The World Language Honor Societies (Mandarin, French, Italian and Spanish) recognize excellence in the study of a world language and commitment to the study of the language and its culture. These organizations emphasize community service and leadership. The first time students are eligible for membership is at the beginning of their junior year, based on the specific academic criteria and service requirement as detailed below. Students who do not meet the criteria in their junior year may be reconsidered for membership at the beginning of their senior year.

Criteria for Eligibility

Students are eligible for induction into a World Language honor society after having completed at least **two consecutive years of study** in the same language at the high school level, **and after having completed a level III or higher course in French, Italian or Spanish or a level II or higher course in Mandarin. Students must maintain all of the following criteria in for two consecutive years before being inducted into an honor society.**

- A or A+ final average in **each of the two years** of language study in an Academic level course.
- A-, A, or A+ final average in **each of the two years** of language study in an Accelerated level course.
- In the year of their induction, typically their junior year, students must be currently enrolled in a level IV or V French, Italian or Spanish class or in a Level III or IV Mandarin class.
- Students must commit to studying their world language through their senior year, or through the highest course level offered.

Service Requirement

Student must be a current member of the corresponding World Language Club for two consecutive years before being inducted into a language honor society. Student complete a minimum of four(4) service activities each year for the World Language Club to which he/she belongs.

Criteria for Maintaining Membership in a World Language Honor Society

Students must continue to maintain the criteria specified in the World Language Honor Society Constitution, which members receive and sign upon induction. The criteria include grade and service requirements. World Language Honor Societies members in good standing are entitled to wear honor cords at graduation, which distinguish them as honor students who have excelled in their study of their specific world language and culture.
