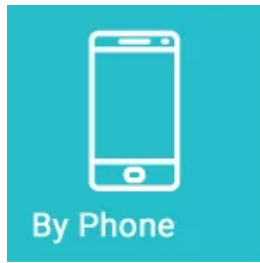

First, you're in crisis. That doesn't just mean suicide; it's any painful emotion for which you need support. You text the word "LEV" to 741741. The first two text responses are automated. The first text tells you that you're being connected with a Crisis Counselor and the second text invites you to share a bit more.

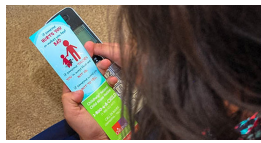
