GENERAL SUPPLIES FOR ALL CLASSES (to be restocked as needed):

- **A pencil case regularly stocked with:**
 - Pencils – if mechanical pencils, extra lead (**please replenish/have enough for the year!**)
 - Pens – a few different colors
 - Highlighters – a few different colors
 - Eraser(s)
 - Sticky Notes/Post-Its
 - 2 Glue Sticks or Tape
 - 2 Fine Point Dry Erase Markers
- Lined composition paper, hole punched, in **all** binders (please have extra at home to replenish throughout the year!)
- Highly Recommended – an active and valid library card
- Headphones
 - Note: Your iPad has a 3.5mm headphone jack. If your headphones have a lightning connector, you will need an adaptor.
- **Fully charged, district provided iPad (inside the district provided case) and the charger**

- A 1-2” binder for each course: Language Arts, Math, World History, Writing Workshop, World Language, & Math Expo
OR
- 2 large 3 ring binders: one for A.M classes. and one for P.M. classes
 - **Math Explorations and French will still need their own “stand alone” 1” binder*
